Responsibilities : Be an active researcher, dedicated to university teaching and supervision of students at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels, including Bachelor's, Master's and PhD degrees. The appointees are also required to undertake administrative responsibilities as assigned by the Head of Department.

Requirements : A PhD in Social Science related disciplines, with teaching experience and strong evidence of research potential. For appointment at Associate Professor level, a substantial track record of published research in internationally recognized outlets is expected. For post (1), applications would be particularly welcome from candidates with a background in economics.

- (3) **Associate Professor/Assistant Professor (Social Entrepreneurship) in the Department of Public and Social Administration/Department of Management** [Ref. C/144/10]

Responsibilities : This is a joint appointment in the Department of Public and Social Administration and the Department of Management. The appointee is expected to be passionate about social entrepreneurship and social business as innovative and sustainable means to address social needs, play a critical role in the development of the University's Social Entrepreneurship Initiative (SEI), and make a strong contribution to the applied and interdisciplinary research in this field. Specific responsibilities include fostering cross departmental and interdisciplinary collaboration in the development of courses covering the concepts, practices and skills of social entrepreneurship/social innovation and Student Service Leadership; participation in the delivery of such courses, mentoring and management of student internships and student experiential learning associated with the SEI.

Requirements : A PhD in Social Sciences/Business Studies, with an excellent understanding of the social entrepreneurship/social innovation and the operating environments of social enterprises/social business. At least 4 years' experience in research and teaching in social entrepreneurship and/or related fields, strong communication and organizational skills; and ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams, and with students and members of the social enterprise/social innovation community are required. Hands-on experience in initiating or managing a social enterprise would be an advantage.

Salary and Conditions of Service

Remuneration package will be driven by market competitiveness and individual performance. Excellent fringe benefits include gratuity, leave, medical and dental schemes, and relocation assistance (where applicable). Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract.
