Applications are invited for appointment as non-tenure track **Associate Professor/Assistant Professor/Principal Lecturer/Senior Lecturer in Housing Studies in the Department of Urban Planning and Design**, from July 1, 2014, on a three-year fixed-term basis, with the possibility of renewal.

For Associate/Assistant Professorship, applicants should possess a Ph.D. degree and a strong teaching and research track record with the ability to secure research funding. Membership or eligibility for membership of housing or other professional institutes is desirable. **For Principal/Senior Lecturership**, applicants should possess a Ph.D. degree in a relevant discipline with a minimum of 5 years' teaching experience at the tertiary level. They should have substantial teaching and practical experience, though with a lesser research track record. **For both Associate/Assistant Professorship and Principal/Senior Lecturership**, the appointee is expected to develop and teach courses including, but not limited to, courses on housing and urban theory, housing and land policy, management theory, research methods, and other courses for the Master's and Bachelor's degree programmes in Housing Management; and contribute to dissertation supervision, programme administration, organization of research activities in the housing discipline, and teaching of other Master's and Bachelor's degree programmes. A globally competitive remuneration package commensurate with qualifications and experience will be offered. At current rates, salaries tax does not exceed 15% of gross income. The appointment will attract a contract-end gratuity and University contribution to a retirement benefits scheme, totalling up to 15% of basic salary, as well as annual leave and medical benefits. Housing benefits will be provided as applicable.
