ENHR started 2022 with € 28,275 in the account. We ended the year having € 29,459 in the account (an equity of € 16,392 plus € 13,067 fees paid in advance - accrued liability - for 2023, 2024 and even for 2025). This resulted in a difference of € +1,184.

The 2022 ENHR income add up to € 32,220 (fees received in 2020, 2021 and 2022 regarding 2022). Expenses in 2022 add up to € 30,704 (of which € 25,000 are personnel costs). Consequently 2022 resulted in a plus of € 1,516.

The board trusts the present assets will cover the projected 2023 expenses of which the most prominent will be personnel costs, travel costs and the maintenance and service costs of the website and database. Nonetheless ENHR's financial position is being monitored at every coordination committee meeting.
